The Northwest Hills Council of Governments (NHCOC) is developing a Regional Transportation Plan to guide future transportation decisions for our region. It will consider potential needs for all modes of transportation, including automobile, transit, rail, walking, and bicycling. The plan will then prioritize improvement projects and assist in securing the funding to implement these projects.

What is a planning region?
NHCOC is one of nine Connecticut planning regions and is comprised of twenty-one towns in northwest Connecticut. NHCOC provides support to those communities, including planning for the region's transportation needs.

NHCOC is seeking your input to help shape this plan.

Everyone who lives or travels in the region is a stakeholder – and we want to hear from you! We will be holding three transportation forums, each of which will focus on a specific transportation mode.
